

THE 15 SECOND ELEVATOR SPEECH

WHAT IS AN ELEVATOR SPEECH:

10-15 SECONDS LONG3-5 SENTENCESThis is a sales pitch about you.

PREPARE: Study the job description of the position you are seeking. What requirements and qualities are required?

CONSIDER:

Who are you? What are your strengths, training and/or experiences? What are the qualities of someone in the position you are seeking? You are the solution! What do you have to offer? Share examples; be specific

CHECKLIST:

- □ Identify three main ideas. You! The need! You are the solution!
- □ Write down every thought that comes to mind. Create a rough draft.
- □ Structure thoughts and sentences into your bullet points
- □ Edit out unnecessary words or phrases Edit for flow of ideas.
- □ MEMORIZE IT!! Practice! Practice! Practice!
- □ Video yourself!
- □ Practice with peers, family or friends.
